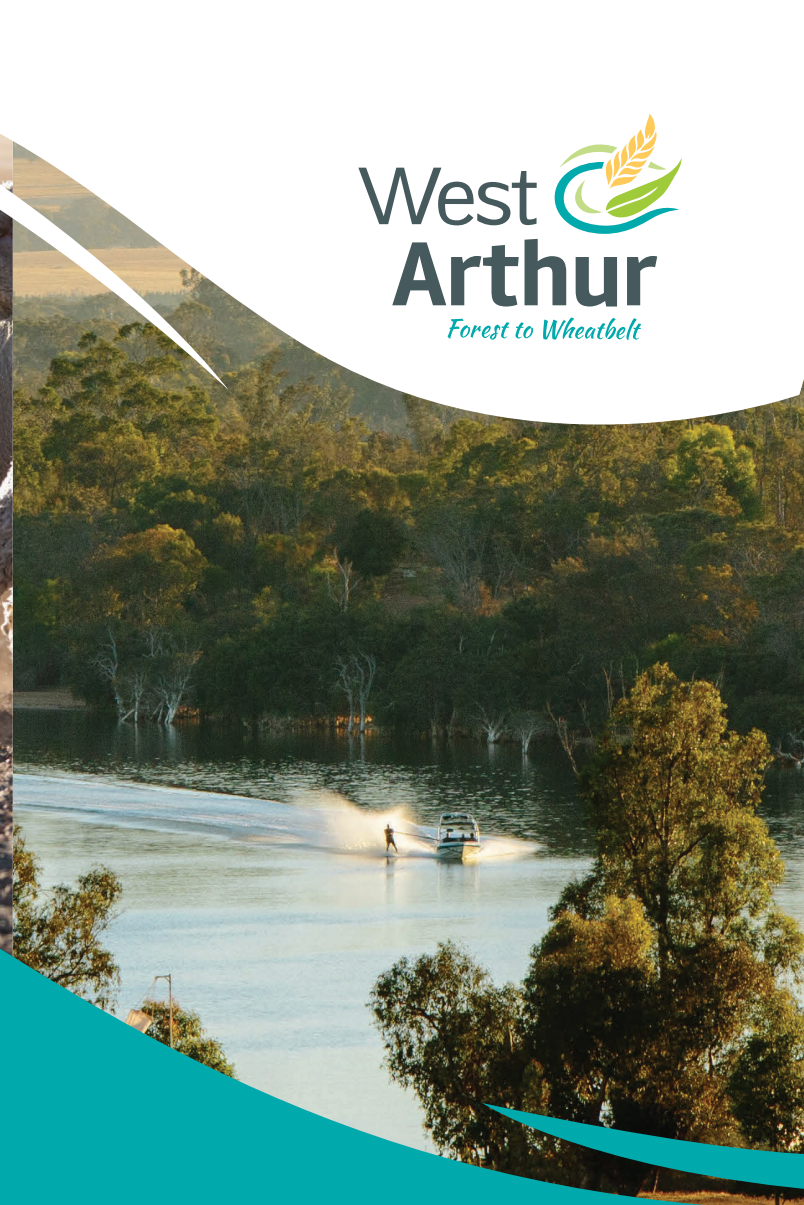

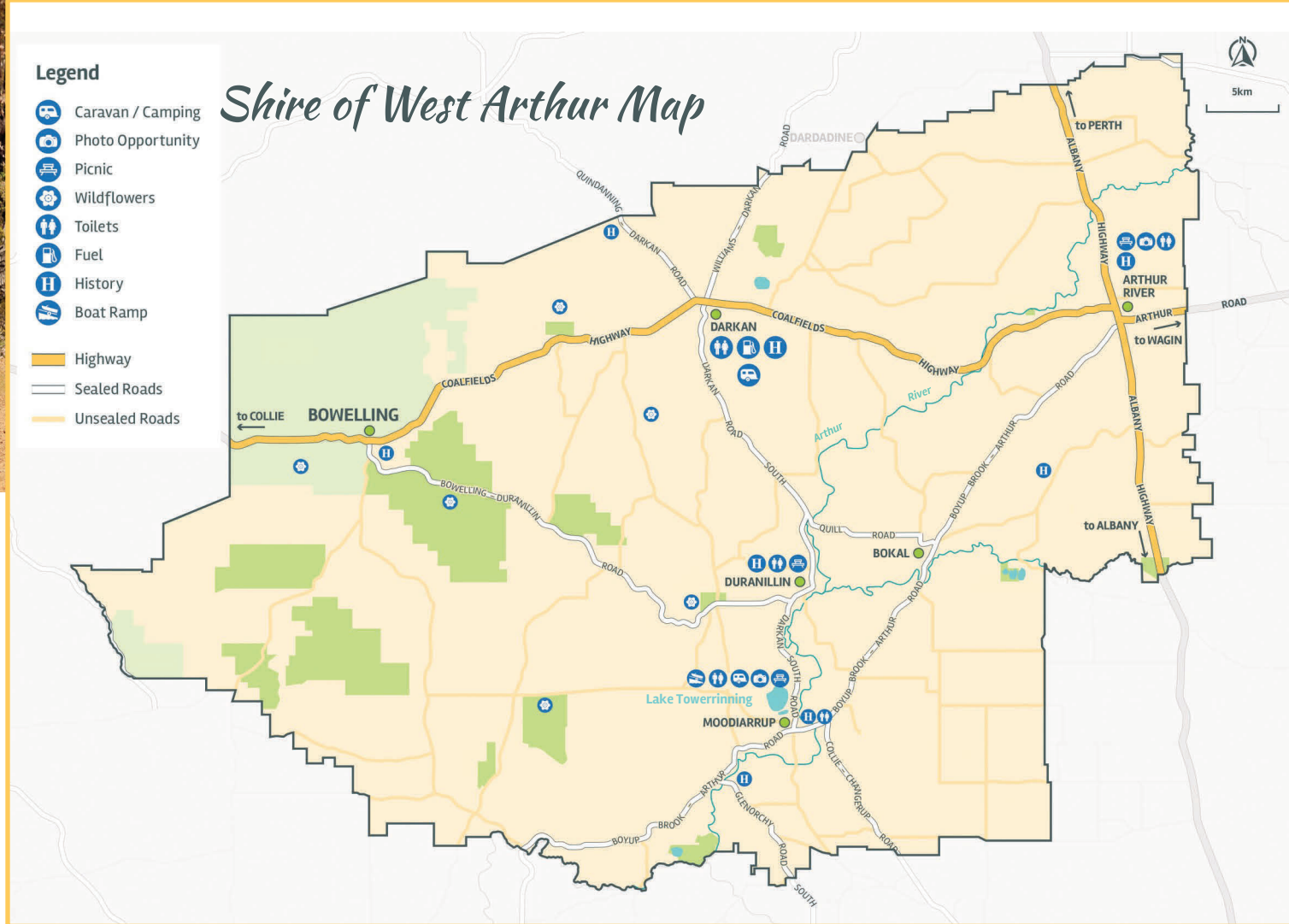


Activities and Things to See

Natural assets, historical buildings and precincts, and play areas for the kids. There is something for everyone in this quiet corner of the world.

Take a visit to Lake Towerrinning and swim, ski, canoe or watch the sunset or stars. If you are looking for a quieter piece of water check out the Arthur River which is accessible from Duranillin or Moodiarrup.

Walk, cycle or horse ride along the Collie to Darkan Rail Trail to see the wildflower displays, or take a drive and visit the various Nature Reserves in the Shire for more wildflower displays.



If it is history that you are interested in, you will enjoy a visit to the Arthur River Heritage precinct or a walk along the Darkan Heritage Trail.
